LPN-to-RN Bridge Program Admission Requirements

Students seeking admission to the LPN-to-RN Bridge Program must submit a complete application packet to the Albany Technical College Nursing Department by the stated deadline. Applications received after the deadline will not be accepted.

Application Deadline: 5:00 p.m., November 1, 2026

Application Packet Requirements

The application packet must include:

- Completed and signed LPN-to-RN Bridge Program Application
- Official ATI TEAS score report
- Official transcripts from all previously attended colleges and universities
- Current, unencumbered, and unrestricted Practical Nurse licensure in Georgia or a compact state
- Current American Heart Association BLS for Healthcare Provider Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) certification

Applicants will be considered for admission based on their qualifications and the completeness of their application packet. To be considered for admission, applicants must meet all the following requirements:

1. **Meet Albany Technical College admission requirements.**
Applicants must be admitted to Albany Technical College and be in good standing.
2. **Meet the minimum Nursing GPA requirement.**
Applicants must have a minimum Nursing GPA of 2.75, based on all nursing curriculum coursework attempted at all institutions attended, including nursing courses considered for transfer credit.
 - See ASN Student Handbook for required program coursework
3. **Meet the minimum ATI TEAS requirement.**
Applicants must earn a minimum overall ATI TEAS score of 60%. The ATI TEAS score must remain valid through the student's program entry of the first RNSG course date, May 17, 2027.
4. **Complete all required program core courses prior to the start of Summer 2027 semester, May 17, 2027.**
 - See ASN Student Handbook for required program coursework

5. Meet nursing program progression and dismissal requirements.

Applicants must not have been excluded or dismissed from a nursing program (RN or BSN) and must not have failed two nursing courses, defined as grades of D, F, or WF, at any college or institution, including Albany Technical College.

- Reasons for exclusion or dismissal may include, but are not limited to, academic misconduct, disruptive or unprofessional behavior, or program failure.

Consideration may be given to nursing course failures that occurred more than three years prior to the application date if the applicant has subsequently practiced as an LPN in an acute-care setting for at least one year.

6. Complete required science courses.

Applicants must complete the following courses with a grade of C or higher in each:

- Anatomy and Physiology I with Lab
- Anatomy and Physiology II with Lab
- Microbiology with Lab

Each required science course must have been completed within five years immediately preceding the first day of RNSG coursework.

For example, students entering the program in Spring 2027 must have completed the required science courses and the science coursework must be valid to begin the first day of RNSG classes, on May 17, 2027.

7. Submit the completed application by the deadline.

Applicants must complete, sign, and submit the LPN-to-RN Bridge Program Application and all required supporting documentation by 5:00 p.m. on November 1, 2026.

8. Receive an admission decision.

Applicants will receive written notification of acceptance or denial of admission by postal mail no later than the first week of December 2026. If applicable, applicants will also receive notification through their valid Albany Technical College student email account.

Step-by-Step Application Process

Step 1: Complete the Albany Technical College General Admission Application

Complete the Albany Technical College General Admission Application online at www.albanytech.edu or in person at the Albany Technical College main campus.

Applicants must meet all general admission requirements for an associate-level program. Completion of the College's general admission application establishes admission to Albany Technical College only and does not constitute an application to the Associate of Science in Nursing (ASN) program or the LPN-to-RN Bridge Program.

Step 2: Complete the ATI TEAS Examination

Take the ATI Test of Essential Academic Skills (ATI TEAS) examination. Testing information is available through the Albany Technical College Testing Center at 229-430-2709 or 229-430-3580. Testing is by appointment only.

Applicants should note the following:

- A minimum overall ATI TEAS score of 60% is required for admission consideration.
- ATI TEAS scores are valid for two years from the examination date.
- Students are limited to two attempts within a 12-month period.
- The two attempts must be at least 30 days apart.
- The most recent valid TEAS score will be designated as the score of record.
- The ATI TEAS score must remain valid through the start date of the nursing (RNSG) courses.
- ATI TEAS examinations taken at another institution or approved ATI testing site may be accepted if the score remains valid.
- It is the student's responsibility to obtain and submit an official ATI transcript for examinations taken at another institution or approved ATI testing site.

Step 3: Submit All Required Official Transcripts

To ensure that all eligible coursework can be evaluated for admission requirements and transfer credit, students must submit official transcripts from every college or institution attended.

Failure to submit official transcripts from all institutions attended will result in an incomplete application and may prevent the application from being considered for admission.

Applicants should request two official transcripts:

1. One transcript for Albany Technical College
2. One transcript for the Nursing Department

Official electronic transcripts for the Nursing Department may be sent to llanier@albanytech.edu.

Official transcripts are required from all previously attended institutions, except that an unofficial ATC transcript may be submitted when ATC is the applicant's only institution attended.

Step 4: Submit the LPN-to-RN Bridge Program Application Packet

Complete and submit the LPN-to-RN Bridge Program application packet, including:

- Completed and signed application
- Official transcripts from all institutions attended
- Official ATI TEAS score report
- Current, unencumbered, and unrestricted Practical Nurse licensure in Georgia or a compact state
- Current American Heart Association BLS for Healthcare Provider Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) certification
