The mission of TitansCARE is to provide a proactive and supportive multi-disciplinary team approach to campus safety by identifying individuals who demonstrate behaviors that are disruptive or threatening.



Our GOALS

- Provide a safe physical environment for members of the college community.
- Provide a safe emotional environment for the college community.
- Promote peace of mind for friends and family of the college community

■ Why a TITANS CARE Team?

The TitansCARE Team assists faculty, staff and students in addressing situations where a person is displaying disruptive, threatening or distressed behavior.

The TitansCARE team examines reports of distressing situations to evaluate risk levels and identify persons whose behavior may endanger their own or others' health and safety. TitansCARE meets, as needed, to review and analyze information in order to address the needs of students who are experiencing significant behavioral disturbances.

Titans Care is not crisis management. A crisis may be defined where a person may pose an active or immediate risk of violence to self or others. Anyone in the ATC community who observes an emergency or behavior that is dangerous or severe should contact ATC Campus Police at 229-430-4711 or 911 immediately.



WHAT BEHAVIORS TO REPORT?

- Repeated or excessive classroom disruptions
- Inappropriate or exaggerated emotional responses to a given situation
- Loss of contact with reality including rambling or hallucinations
- Academic misconduct
- Repeated or excessive classroom disruption
- Drunkenness or being under the influence of illicit drugs on campus property
- Threatening words or actions
- Writings that convey clear intentions to harm self or others
- Observed self-injurious behavior
- Online postings in social media that involve direct and explicit threats
- Suicidal behavior, including threats
- Acts or overt expressions motivated by hatred or discrimination
- Paranoia or delusion
- Stalking a staff member or another student
- Intimate partner violence

HOW DO I MAKE A REFERRAL?

It is the responsibility of faculty, staff and students to immediately report any situation that could possibly result in harm to anyone in the college community. Individuals can submit referrals in the following ways:
