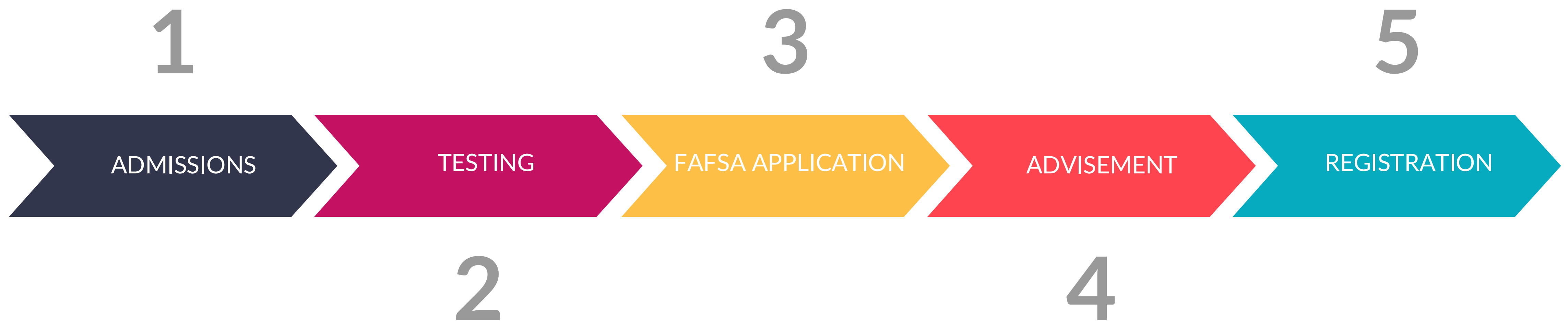

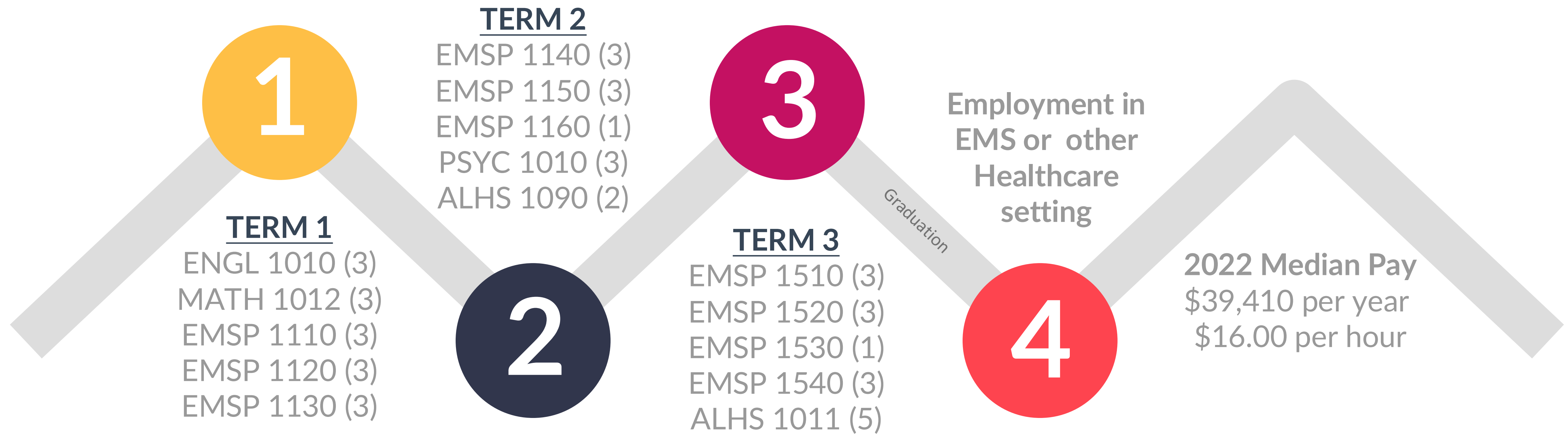
Credits required for graduation: 42
